

## How to Setup SPAM Filters in Mozilla Thunderbird 1.0.7

1. Click “Tools”.
2. Click “Message Filters” (figure 1):

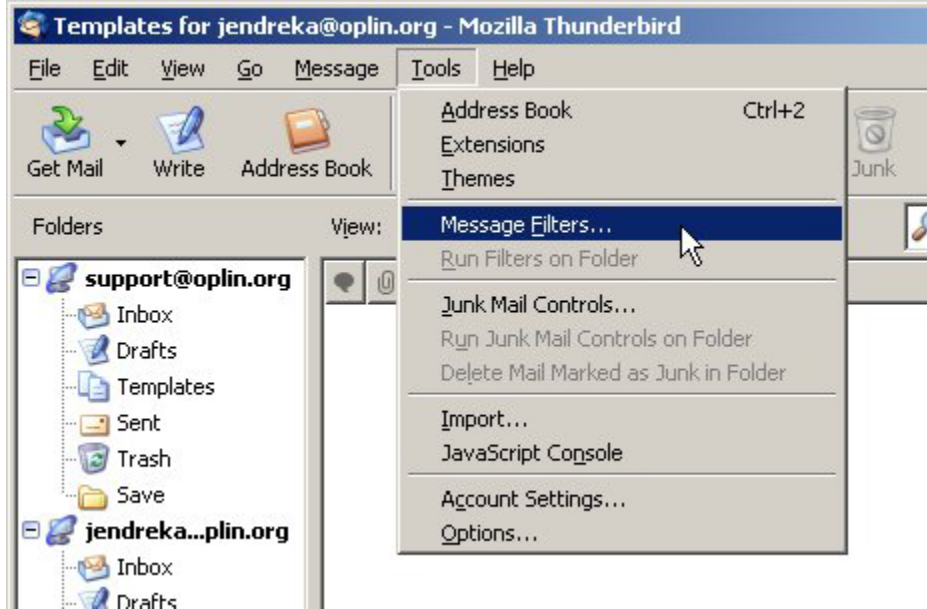

3. Select “Customize” in the first box (figure 2):

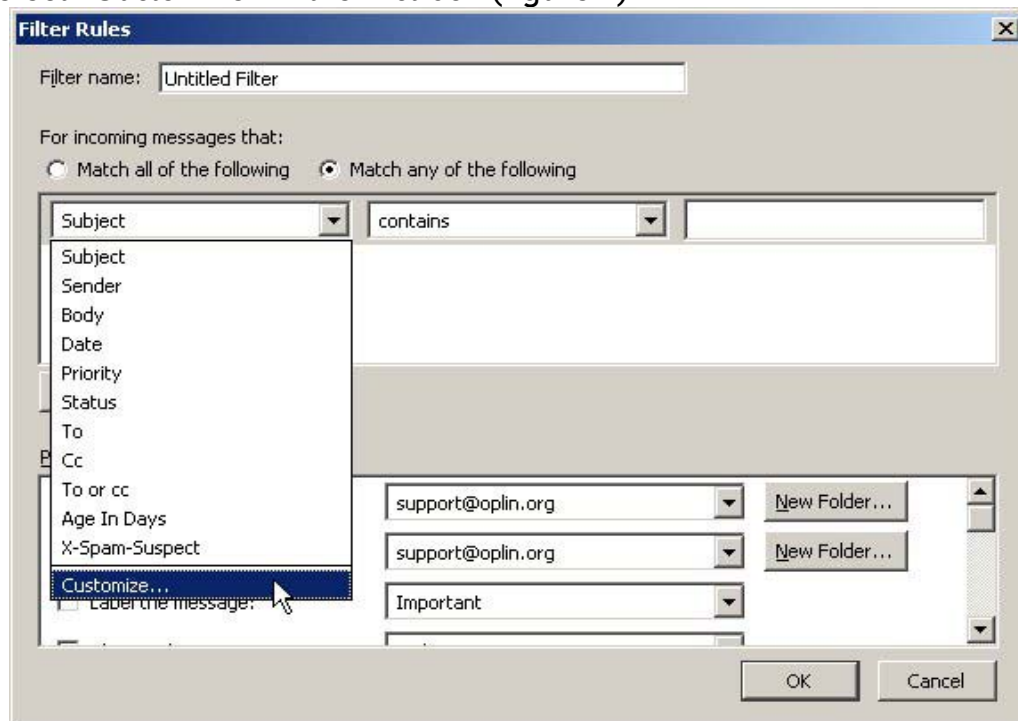

4. Click “New”.

5. In the “New Message Header” box, type “X-Spam-Suspect” (figure 3):

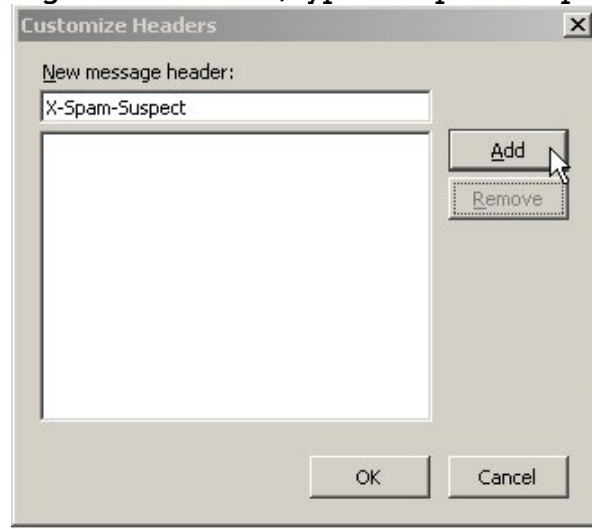

6. Click “Add”, then click “OK”.

7. Select “X-Spam-Suspect” in the first box.

8. Select “Contains” in the second box

9. Type “YES” in the third box.

10. Select the action you prefer from the menu at the bottom. Your window should now look mostly like figure 4:

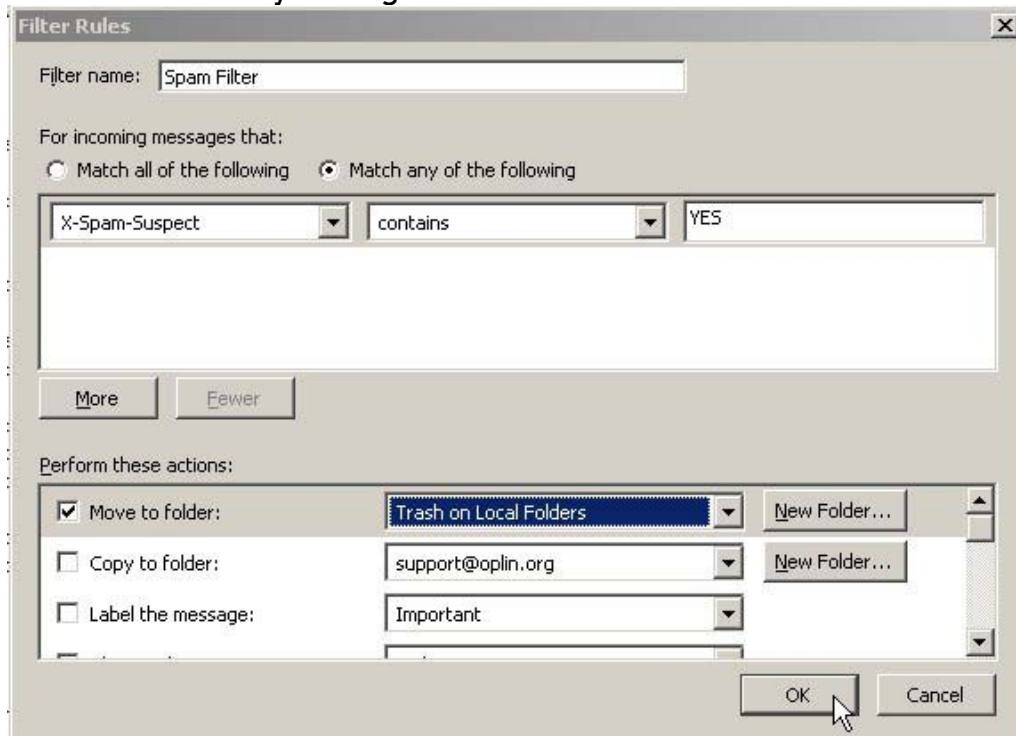
